

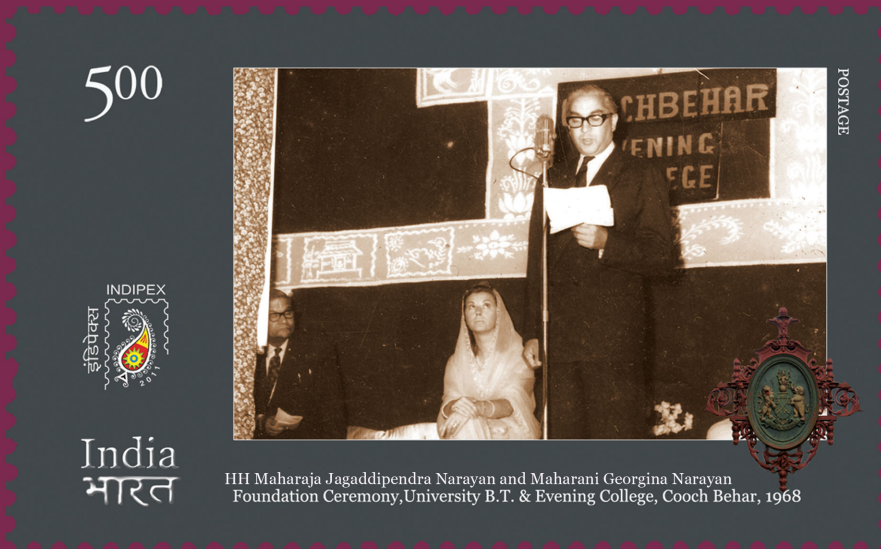

## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

University B.T. & Evening College, Cooch Behar, is a constituent college of the University of North Bengal. It was established on 25 August 1968, with a view to giving teachers' training and helping the local youth to earn their first degree. The institution started its journey with the blessings of Maharaja Jagaddipendra Narayan and Maharani Georgina Narayan, the last royal couple of the Cooch Behar Princely State (foundation day picture on cover).

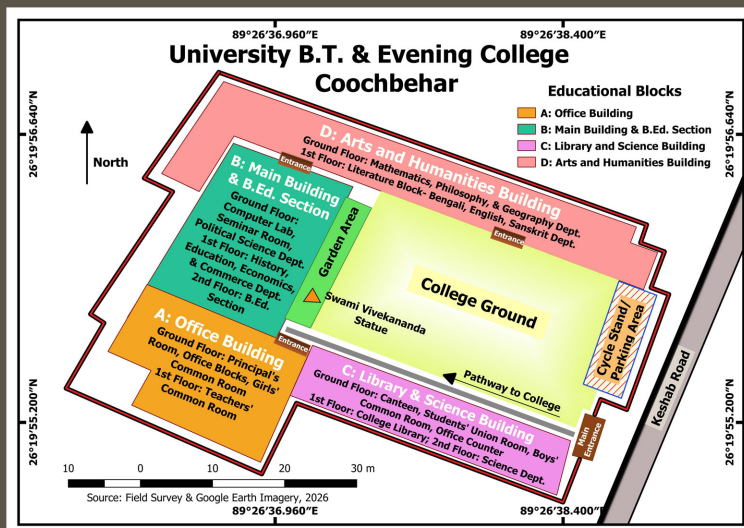
The classes began at Cooch Behar Uchcha Madhyamik Vidyalaya at Madan Mohan Colony, Kalighat Road in the suburban area of Cooch Behar. The first Principal of the college was Prof S.N. Basak, Head, Dept. of Economics who came on deputation from the University of North Bengal. The college was shifted to the present site (at Junior Polytechnic Institute) in the year 1972 when Prof. N.C. Bhowmick (who came on lien from Jalpaiguri A.C. College of Commerce) was the Principal. The Junior Polytechnic Institute was initially hired by the University on rental basis. The land and the building were later handed over to the college. Now the college has an area of 0.9 acre in which a three-storied building stands in addition to two recently built wings, and a staff quarter.



## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

With the coming of National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), the college applied for recognition and was duly granted by the Council w.e.f 1995 which continues to act as a shot in the arm for the college as it is only one of the three colleges in North Bengal to receive this honour. Apart from being affiliated to the University of North Bengal, the college is also included under sections 2(f) and 12B of the University Grants Commission (UGC). The college has been twice assessed and accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council of India (NAAC) in 2006 and 2013.

# COURSE OF STUDIES

The college offers three courses of studies: two in its Degree section and one in the B.Ed. section:

## *Single Major and Single Minor*

A student will identify **one Major Course** in which he/she will concentrate. Apart from the one Core Major Course, he/she will have to select **one Minor Course**. He/she will also have to select

- Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC) courses,
- Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC),
- Value Added Courses (VAC), and
- Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)

from the provided pool of courses.

## *Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary)*

A student will identify **two courses** in which he/she will concentrate. Apart from these two courses, he/she will have to select **one Minor course**. He/she will also have to select

- Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC) courses,
- Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC),
- Value Added Courses (VAC), and
- Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)

from the provided pool of courses.

## *B. Ed. (Teachers' Training)*

The college also offers B.Ed. course for students who wish to pursue a career in school teaching and in-service school teachers who have to acquire the degree. The students have to select five **Core** papers, two **Method** papers and one **Special** paper from the pool of courses provided by the college.





## OUTLINES OF 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME

### A. Major Course (MAJ) (4 credits each):

One/two major courses chosen from the combination of subjects that a student is expected to imbibe in that particular discipline. A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a requirement is termed as a Major Course.

### B. Minor Course (MIN) (4 credits each):

One Minor courses, to be chosen from the combination of subjects, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice is called a Minor Course. The purpose of this category of these courses is to offer the students the option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in Major.

### C. Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC) (3 credits each):

All UG students are required to undergo 3-introductory-level courses relating to any of the BROAD DISCIPLINES and whose difficulty level, should not be higher than the +2 level. Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already undergone at the Higher Secondary Level (12th) class under this category. A student cannot study IDCs from the same broad discipline.

#### **D. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) (3 credits each):**

These courses (three in number) may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and should contain both theory and laboratory/hands-on training/field work. The prime purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hands-on mode so as to increase their employability.

SEC shall be designed in such a manner that a student from any stream could gain Technical/Practical/Hands-on/ Earning based etc. at the exit of the programme. Such courses should be not necessarily more than 10 in number for each semester.

#### **E. Internship (2 credits):**

A student will also have to undergo internship once either at the end of 2nd semester or at the end of 4th semester during Summer Vacations.

#### **F. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) (2 credits each):**

One papers of each of the Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) may be of two kinds, both pertaining to enhancement in ability in language subjects:

- a) Single Major and Single Minor course: Compulsory English to be studied in 2nd Semester and one from MIL Bengali or Alternative English to be studied in the 3rd Semester.
- b) Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary): Compulsory English to be studied in 3rd Semester and one from MIL Bengali or Alternative English to be studied in the 2nd Semester.

#### **G. Value Added Courses (VAC) (4 credits each):**

These courses include courses based on Environmental Education and Value based education:

- a) Single Major and Single Minor course: Environmental Education to be studied in 1st Semester and Understanding India to be studied in the 4th Semester.
- b) Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary): Environmental Education to be studied in 4th Semester and Understanding India to be studied in the 1st Semester.

## Eligibility for Admission:

### Single Major and Single Minor course:

Percentage of Marks:

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Single Major and Single Minor course of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. if he/ she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognised by the University as equivalent thereto.

Provided that a candidate who has obtained (a) 55% marks in the aggregate, or (b) 50% in the aggregate with 60% marks in a subject / related subject in the last qualifying Examination shall be eligible to apply for Single Major and Single Minor course in that subject.

Admission shall however be on merit and availability of seats.

Provided that for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD candidates- the minimum marks for eligibility shall be as per Rules of the State Government.

Provided further that in matter of eligibility 54.5% marks or above shall be equal to 55%, 49.5% and above shall be equal to 50% and 59.5 marks or above shall be equal to 60%.



## Eligibility for Admission:

### Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary):

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Multidisciplinary Course of B.A. / B.Com if he/ she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognised by the University as equivalent thereto.

A candidate shall be allowed to pursue B.A. / B. Com Multidisciplinary Course if he/ she passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subjects. Such students shall have the option to study up to the end of 6<sup>th</sup> semester.



## Merit Calculation:

The following formula is applying for calculation

For a **Single Major and Single Minor Course** (4 year UG), where a student has studied the subject at + 2 level = (Marks obtained in Major/related subject + Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other two subjects)/4.

For a **Single Major and Single Minor Course** (4 year UG), where a student has not studied the subject at+2 level= (Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects)/4.

For a **three discipline-specific Multidisciplinary Course**  
= (Marks obtained in English + Marks obtained in 3 Core/related subjects)/4.

### \* RULES RELATED WITH ADMISSION

A student may be admitted to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Single Major Program & Multidisciplinary Course after passing the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or examinations conducted by Indian School Certificate (ISC) or Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or any other board recognized as equivalent provided he/she has passed in at least four subjects with English as Compulsory Subject, excluding Environmental Studies/ Environmental Science/ Environmental Education.

### \* RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation of seats for online admission into B.A./ B.Sc./ B. Com Single Major Course & Multidisciplinary Course for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ EWS and persons with disabilities are to be maintained as per the relevant G.O.s (3% Reservation of Seats for persons with disabilities vide G.O. No. ED-340/2012, Kolkata, Dt. 04/07/2012), and also considering the amendments as proposed in the notification no. 621-Edn(U)/EH/IU-89/13 dated 25/06/2015, issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal.

- Fresher Candidates with B.E or B. Tech with Science / Mathematics (with 300 marks) with 55% marks or any other equivalent qualification thereto are eligible. For B.E./ B. Tech put marks in Honours Row & for M. Tech/M.E. put marks in Master's row
- Fresher SC/ST Candidates with minimum 45% marks in UG or PG level can Apply
- Fresher General, OBC Candidates within 35 years and SC/ST within 40 years can Apply
- For Deputed Candidates having at least 1 years experience from Govt, Govt. Aided or Govt. sponsored school can apply
- Deputed Candidates must produce original MC/GB Permission, Approval and NOC along with Annexure-I Form at the time of Counselling
- Deputed Candidates have no Age limit

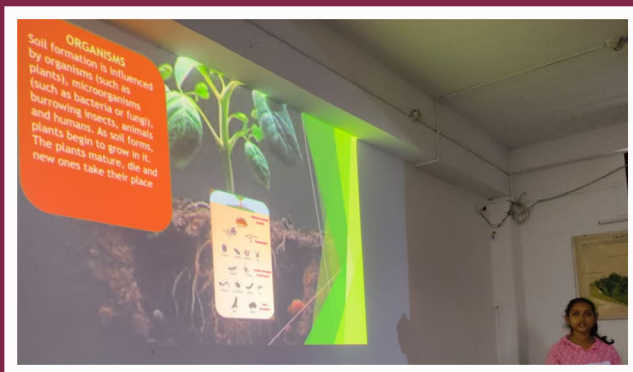

## College Library:
