Activity

On the occasion of World Environment Day 2026, the NSS Unit organized a social outreach programme to promote environmental awareness and community service. The theme for this year, "Our Land. Our Future.", was reflected through the activities conducted by the volunteers. Activities Conducted Drinking Water Distribution Drive for the Passersby. NSS volunteers set up a water station for thirsty pedestrians and daily commuters to combat the summer heat. The initiative aimed to promote the spirit of service while addressing the immediate need for hydration during peak temperatures. Over 200 people benefited from the drive.

Sapling Distribution Programme to encourage afforestation and green practices, volunteers distributed saplings of native trees to passersby. Each recipient was briefed on the importance of planting trees, their role in reducing carbon footprint, and maintaining ecological balance. Around 150 saplings were distributed.



Objective

The programme was organized with the dual objective of providing immediate relief to people during extreme heat and spreading awareness about environmental conservation. It also encouraged public participation in building a greener and healthier community.
