



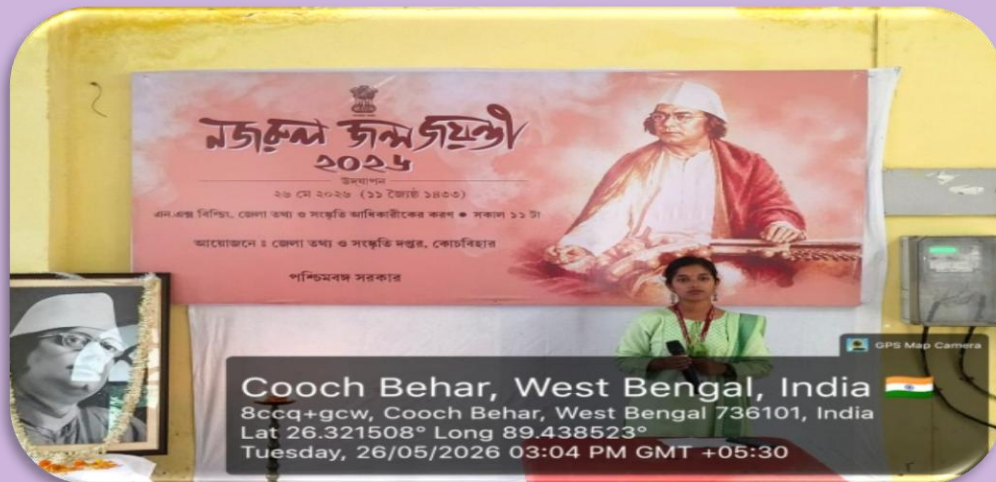
Inaugural Session
